III COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- 1. The cellist soloists of the Republic of Lithuania and foreign music and art schools and conservatoires are invited to take part in the competition.
- 2. The ensembles of the Republic of Lithuania and foreign music and art schools and conservatoires, whose composition may be mixed but the participation of the cellist is obligatory, are invited to participate in the competition of chamber ensembles. In the competition of chamber ensembles, concertmasters may be pupils or pedagogues.
- 3. The soloist competitioners are divided into 4 age groups:

Group A up to 10 years old

Group **B** 11 - 13 years old

Group C 14 - 16 years old

Group \mathbf{D} 17 – 19 years old

4. The competitioners of the ensembles are divided into two age groups:

Group A 7-12 years old

Group **B** 13 - 18 years old

IV REPERTOIR

- 1. The soloist competitioners must perform two plays of different character:
 - Group A up to 5 mins.
 - Group \mathbf{B} up to 7 mins.
 - Group \mathbf{C} up to 9 mins.
 - Group \mathbf{D} up to 10 mins.
- 2. The competitioners of the ensembles must perform two pieces of different character.
 - Group \mathbf{A} up to 7 mins.
 - Group \mathbf{B} up to 10 mins.

All pieces are performed by heart, no repetition is required.

V EVALUATION

The jury, whose members are invited by the organizing committee, will evaluate the performance of the competitioners. The names of the jury members will be announced at the start of the competition. The decisions of the jury are final and unquestionable.

VI AWARDS

- 1. The laureates of the competition will be awarded with diplomas and spec. of the laureates.
- 2. The graduates of the competition will be awarded with diplomas and spec. prizes.
- 3. Special awards:
 - a. For the youngest competitioner.
